This church will remain my home away from home. I intend to continue to serve in education, PADS, and in other areas where my gifts may be needed, and I am called.


You are special to me. I know that you will support my successor with the love and respect that you have shown me. I look forward to being your sister in Christ for years to come.



Approximately fifty (50) volunteers have arrived at our UPC PADS Site each Thursday /Friday since October 4, when our 28th season started, to make sure people who are experiencing homelessness have a safe warm shelter for the night, a delicious dinner and breakfast, and a lunch prepared by St. Gilbert students to take with them when they leave the next morning.

Most of these volunteers are at the site to do their scheduled jobs once a month or periodically throughout the season. However, many of them give of their time two or three times each month, and some are volunteering at the site EVERY Thursday for all 30 nights

of the season!

We want to take this time to acknowledge the dedication and commitment of each one of these very special people! They are truly making the difference between life and death for hundreds because they help to serve almost 300 separate individuals during each PADS season.
