We will begin our Lenten Season celebrating Ash Wednesday on February 14, 2018. Our Lenten Season is a time of fasting, repentance, moderation and spiritual discipline. I have always felt our Lenten Season should include witness, which is why I celebrate Ash Wednesday a little differently. There will be no evening worship service this year instead you can meet me between 7am-9am at Somethings Brewing (82 Center Street, Grayslake) for coffee/tea and Ashes. Please invite your friends and neighbors to join you. If you can not make that, stop by the church between 11am- 1pm to receive your Ashes. If those two options do not work for you I will have Ashes to Go available on Sunday February 11. This is a sort of do-it-yourself kit.

I have also purchased for you *The Sanctuary for Lent 2018* by Katie Z. Dawson. This pamphlet contains daily scripture reading, a short devotion and closing prayer. These daily readings help readers faithfully journey through Lent as they prepare to experience the joy of the Resurrection. It will be available Sunday February 11, 2018.

I do not know about you but during Lent I'm often asked what I am giving up. I know this can be a practice of Spiritual Discipline that is helpful to many, but I have not found that to be true for me. One year my daughter said she was giving up green foods. I pointed out to her she did not eat green foods so that would not really work. Instead of giving up something I add something, a service to others. This can take on many different forms depending on who I encounter daily. So often the season of Lent is spent focusing inward that we miss seeing the needs of our neighbors.

Class Notes

It's 2018, and I have begun my 23rd year as Director of Christian Education at the UPC. I continue to be guided by the Holy Spirit and inspired by God's Love for the opportunity to serve Him through this UPC congregation. With support from the staff and volunteers, this work has been a blessing.

In 2017 my job responsibilities included the following: to administer all education programs, to support the parents and teaching staff, to teach children, youth and adults, to facilitate PUSH, to consult with all age levels in the areas of curriculum selection and program support including the All-Church Lenten Study, to find and/or write education programs for the edification of our membership including a spiritual retreat, and to provide publicity for children's and adult's programs. I was able to teach JIF workshops, Bible skills classes, to direct the cross cultural Vacation Bible School, to lead adult classes such as the Lenten study, *Becoming a Good Samaritan, Forgiveness: Finding Peace through Letting Go, Hoodwinked: Ten Myths Moms Believe and Why We All Need to Knock It Off,* and to write and lead the Spiritual Retreat "Remember the SABBATH" for seventeen participants at the Cardinal Stritch Retreat House. I was also able to attend an 8-Day Ignatius Spiritual Retreat in Barrington, IL where I was immersed in silence and study of the Word with the local Jesuits.

PUSH (Pray Until Something Happens) continued to be my small group support for my ministry and life. PUSH, which began as a prayer/Bible study group for UPC teachers, is now a small covenant group that has been together for fifteen years and is involved in intercessory prayer and study of the Word. In 2017 we once again prayed for hundreds of concerns.

In 2017 it was my privilege to partner in ministry with our devoted church staff including Pastor Joan, Joann Baraksa, Candi Becker, Dave Bartz, Karen Knapp, Sean Del Grosso and Marcia Twadell.
